JOHN, RICHARD, AND MARY BRONSON (BROWNSON OR BRUNSON)

The Bronson-Brownson-Brunson family was established in the New World by John who left Massachusetts under the leadership of The Reverend Thomas Hooker to settle at Hartford in Connecticut in 1636. In John's party were his wife Frances and two daughters, his brother Richard, and a sister Mary. It is quite certain that this party left London in July 1635 and landed in Boston in October the 8 that year from the ship "Defense" with Edward Bostock, Master. Thomas Hooker served parishes in England in the vicinity of Earl's Colne and it is likely that they knew his leadership before coming to the New World, if fact, may have come because of his teachings. Several people have presented books and papers on this family, and related that the three Bronson people came with their father "Old Richard" to Hartford. Mr. Donald Lines Jacobus, genealogist of New Haven, ably corrects this misconception after collaborating with Mrs. V. Hiddon of Fisk House, Iver, Bucks County, England, who examined the parish records of Earl's Colne, Lamarsh, and Halstead. His conclusions are published in THE AMERICAN GENEALOGIST of Oct. 1962, Part 1 Vol. 38:193. He establishes that John, Richard, and Mary are children not of a Richard, but of a Roger Brownson of Earl's Colne by citing birth dates of these people as sons and daughter of Roger born at Earl's Colne, the son of John of that parish and his wife Mary Underwood. Roger and Mary were married 12 May 1600, and their son John was bapt. 21 September 1602 at Lamarsh, Richard was bapt. 23 July 1615, and sister Mary was born about 6 March 1622/3. John, our immigrant, was married July 1605 according to the St. Andrew's Church Register of Halstead County, Essex. They had children born in England, two daughters who migrated with the group and two sons who died before the migration. Mr. Jacobus gives a detailed account of this family and its background in England.

John b. or bapt. 21 Sept. 1602, Lamarsh, Essex, England, migrated to Boston in 1635, and to Hartford 1636, again to Farmington in 1641 as a planter, died there in 1680, the inventory of his estate of 312 was taken November 28 of that year. He had served in the Pequot War of 1637 and for that service was assigned land in the "Soldiers Field". While living at Farmington he served the town as Constable, organizer of the Church of Farmington and as Deputy of the General Court several terms. His family was:

11. Mary, bapt. 12 Dec. 1627 Earl's Colne, England, married John Wyatt, m. 2nd. John Graves, m. 3rd. William Allis, and m. 4th. Samuel Gaylord. She d. after 1694 leaving nine children.
12. John Brownson who was bapt. 1628 and died 1631 Earl's Colne England.
13. John Brownson II was bapt. Dec. 1631 and died before 1635, also at Earl's Colne, England.
14. Dorcas, bapt. at Earl's Colne, England married in Conn. Stephen Hopkins and they had six children.
15. Sarah b. ca. 1639 at Hartford, their first child born in the New World. Sarah married Sgt. John Kilbourn of Wethersfield. They had six children.
16. Jacob b. Jan. 1640/41 at Hartfor, d. March 1707/8 Farmington. He m.

- Mary (Andrews) Barnes. Their story is on the next page.
17. John Bronson b. Jan. 1643/44 Farmington and d. 1696. He m. Sarah Ventris and they had seven children.
 18. Sgt. Isaac Bronson b. Nov. 1645 Farmington, and d. 19 Feb. 1719/20. He m. Mary Root and settled at Waterbury. They had nine children.
 19. Abraham Bronson bapt. 28 Nov. 1647 at Farmington, d. 27 June 1719 at Lyme, Conn. He m. Ann or Hannah Griswold and had nine children.

JACOB BRUNSON OF FARMINGTON

16. Jacob who now uses the Brunson spelling, was the sixth child of John and Frances Hills Brownson. Brownson was the spelling in the English church records for four generations without variation and so it is difficult to understand why there is such variance in the spelling in the New World, but generally the families have come to use the Bronson as preferred, except in the south where the Carolina family used the Brunson spelling. Brownson is not commonly used by this family at this time in history. Jacob married Mary Andrews, daughter of John and Mary Andrews and the 2nd. wife and widow of Thomas Barnes. He acquired much property which he shared generously with all his children at his death. Their family was:

161. Samuel Brounson b. abt. 1675 Farmington and d. 27 Oct. 1733 at New Milford. He married Lydia Warner, daughter of John of Waterbury and Farmington and they had six children.
162. Elizabeth b. abt. 1676/7, d. 3 Sept. 1733. At Woodbury, she married William Harris of Hartford, Wethersfield and Hatfield. They had seven children.
163. Rebecca b. ca. 1679, d, 2 May 1755 at Wethersfield. She married Eliphalet Dickinson of Wethersfield and Hatfield. They had seven children.
164. Jacob Brunson Jr. b. abt. 1680 at Kensington and d. unmar. abt. May 1710. His will establishes all his brothers and sisters.
165. Roger Brunson b. 1692 at Farmington, d. 16 Feb. 1758 at New Milford. He married Dorcas of Milford and they had nine children.
166. Isaac Bronson, bapt. 28 Nov. 1686 Farmington. He settled at Lyme and married abt. 1710 Thankful Dibble daughter of Samuel, and a divorced wife of Isaac Brownson - descendant of Richard Brownson who had settled in South Carolina. This couple had eight children. Their firstborn appears on page 3.
167. Hannah bapt. 28 Oct. 1688 at Farmington, died young.

We find here the introduction of still a fourth spelling of this name - Brounson - but one that is not as common now as Bronson or Brunson, although the Bronson family to be found in large collections of genealogy throughout the country, and especially in the State Library at Hartford and the Bronson Library at Waterbury reveal the ramifications of these many families which stem from John and Richard's grandchildren. I do not attempt to repeat here what is readily available elsewhere in the comprehensive record put out by Col. Herbert Bronson Enderton. In generations which migrated into New York and New Hampshire and gave birth to the families I wish to record as additions to Col. Enderton's fine work. Page 3 continues the Isaac above #166.

The records kept by Stephen Todd Bronson and Eliza Bronson Howlett Shirley and clippings kept by the latter were of great help with the later families.

Richard, Jacob, Abraham and Isaac. John Brownson, one of the imigrant ancestors, was one of the seven pillars of the organization of the church at Farmington. John deid in Farmington, November 28, 1680. His wife's name is uncertain, but they had six children: (1) . Jacob married Mary and he lived in Hartford where he died in 1708. (2). John Jr. , married Sarah Ventries, lived at Waterbury, he died in 1696. (3). Isaac, born on December 7, 1645, married Mary Root, lived at Waterbury. (4). Abraham, married Hannah Griswold, lived at Lyme, Connecticut. (5). Dorcas married Steven Hopkins of Hartford, Connecticut . (6). Sarah, married Ebenezer Kilbourn of Wethersfield, Connecticut. Descendants of the immigrant John Brunson, Brownson , Bronson have scattered to most of the states of America. They Have been very prominent throughout the centries in forming our American way of life. Some of this branch of the Brunson family spell their name Bronson and Branson are considered to be the Northern line or branch of the family. Today, a large population lives in New York and Connecticut. Only one branch of the John Brownson family moved as far south as North Carolina. John's only brother , Richard is the ancestor of the southern branch of the Brunson Families. Rest of the family deviated to this.

Descendents of Martin Brownson born in Canada (Quebec?) in 1789 and died after the 1871 census. (The date is unsure) He married Hannah Lewis, also born in Canada in 1805. Hannah died after the 1861 census was taken. There were nine children born and are listed below. The second child was John Martin and the family history contained in this book are descendents and their spouses, Margaret Harman and Mary Anne Liberty. The #1 at the beginning of each name represents Martin Brownson. The letter "B" stands for John Martin being the second son (see asterisk). The following numbers indicate whether it is 1st, 2nd, etc. son or daughter of that generation. The generation is in brackets at the top left of each page.

OBITUARY; THOMAS BROWNSON

Thomas Brownson, 80, route 1, Seymour, died Friday noon at his home after a short illness. He was born in Madoc, On. Canada, Dec. 16, 1867. He was a member of the Methodist church of Seymour and a member of a Masonic Lodge No. 306.
