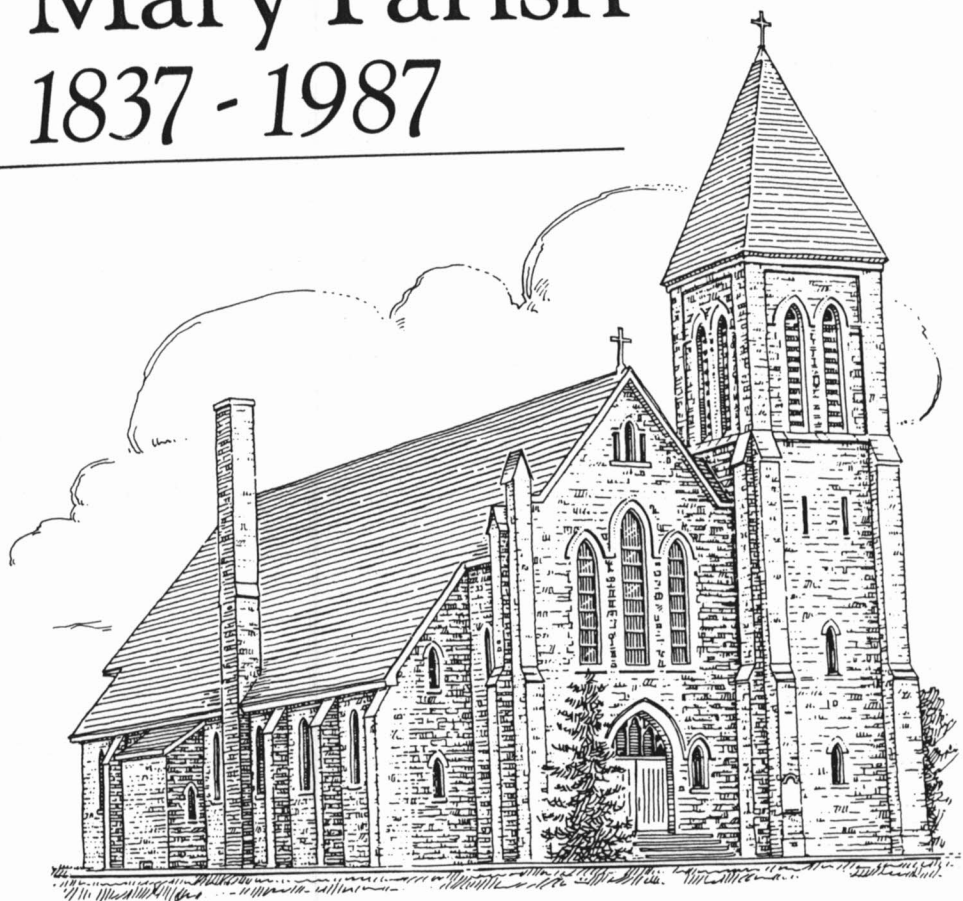

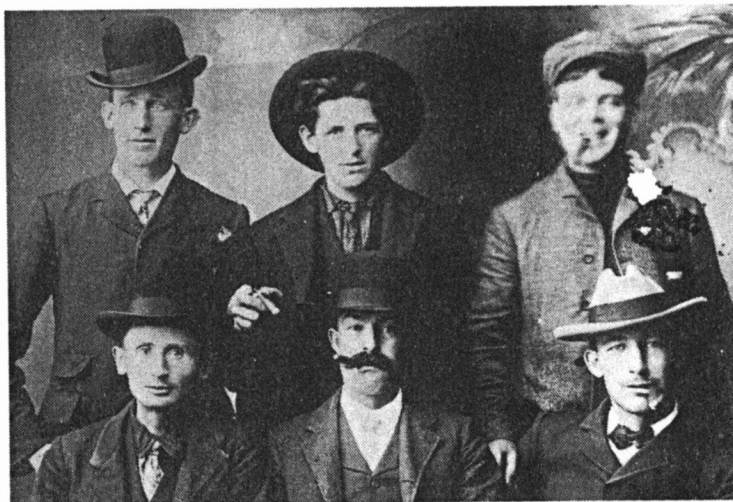

In 1967 Archbishop Wilhelm assigned Father Flurey the task of organizing a new parish in west end Kingston which became known as Our Lady of Lourdes. This parish began with two hundred families and since that time has grown to one thousand families served by four separate schools, two curates and their competent pastor. Father Flurey was assigned to Sacred heart of Mary at Madoc in 1988 and four years later he moved to the pastorate of St. John's at Gananoque where he still resides.

Callaghan, Rev. Thomas P.

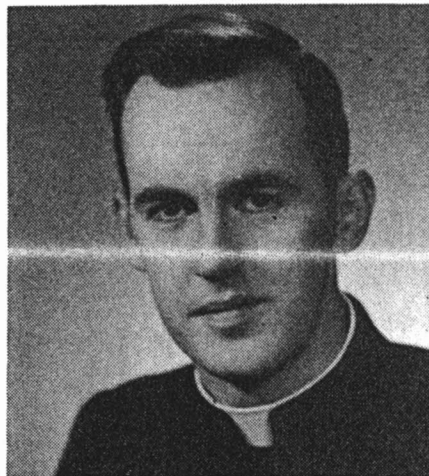
Thomas Peter Callaghan was the youngest son of Maurice J. Callaghan and Ellen Tighe. He was a native of Belleville and received his education at St. Michael's Academy; St. Michael's High School; St. Mary's, Brockville; and the Redemptorist Seminary, Woodstock, Ontario, from whence he was ordained on July 19th, 1955 by His Grace Bishop Cody of London.

Father Callaghan's first Solemn High Mass was on the Sunday following at St. Michael's in the presence of his family and an overflowing attendance of parishioners and friends. He was assisted by his cousin Rev. Michael Callaghan of Sarnia as deacon, Rev. J.A. Carley, English speaking secretary of the Canadian Catholic Conference of Ottawa, as subdeacon, and V. Rev. Dean L.B. Garvin as arch priest.

A family dinner was held at Golden Acres Inn with special guests including Rev. C.E. Baker of Stoco, Rev. J.J. Buckley, Belleville and Rev. Matthew Meehan, rector of St. Mary's College, Brockville, who had delivered the sermon at Mass. Following the dinner the Catholic Women's League, under the direction of the President, Mrs. B.E. Burley, Mrs. E. Logan, Mrs. Frank Domenico and Mrs. F.R. Ross, tendered a reception at Tobe's County Gardens for hundreds of parishioners and friends. On Sunday evening Father Callaghan presided at Solemn Benediction assisted by Rev. Peter Murphy of St. Michael's and Rev. Joseph Shannon of Tweed. Representatives of all parish societies were present in the sanctuary for the reading of a citation and the presentation of a purse. Edwin Esbaugh read the citation and Ernest Cook made the presentation.

Following ordination Father Callaghan returned to Woodstock for an additional year of study and then served as curate at Minnow Lake and Windsor prior to completing his B.A. Degree at Assumption College. He then joined the teaching staff at St. Mary's College, Brockville where he remained until 1964 when he was moved to St. Patrick's Church, Toronto. While at Toronto he served as Procurator of the Order prior to his taking up a pastorate in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island.

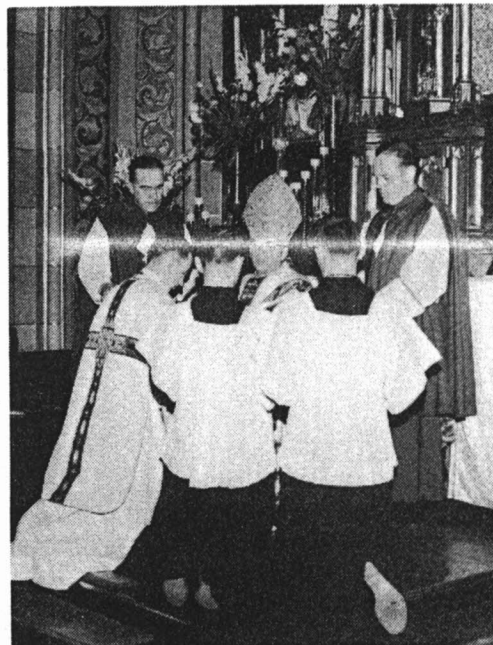
