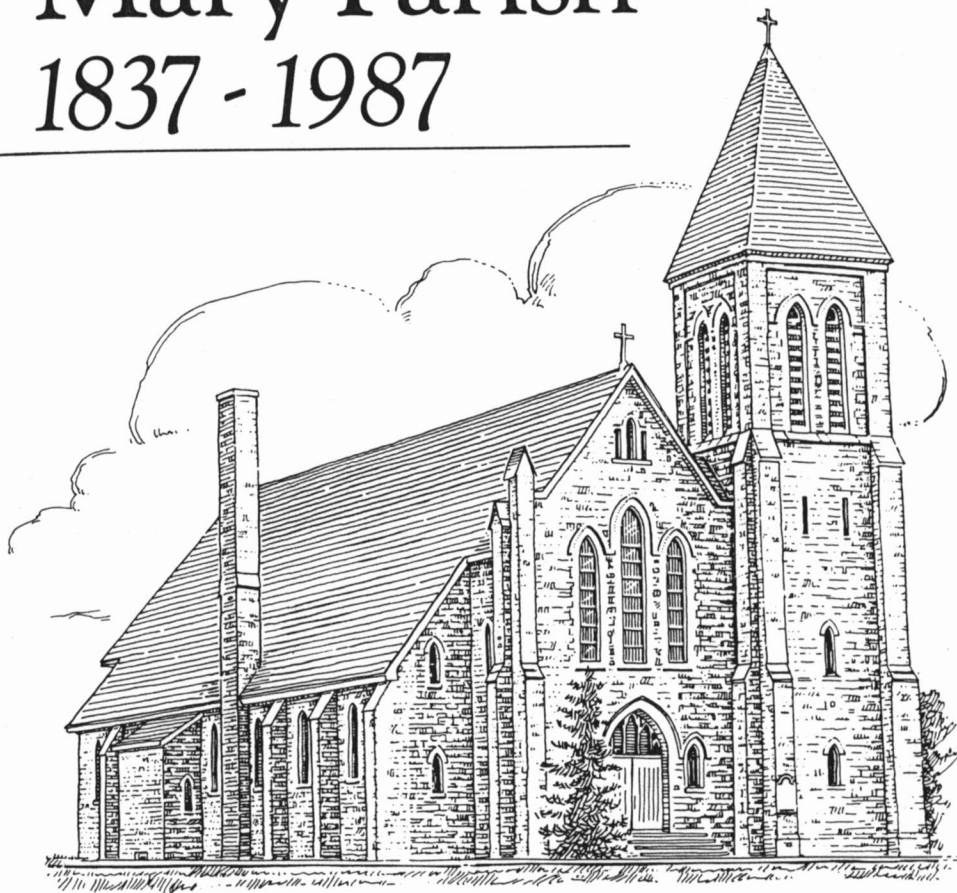


The Story of Holy Name of Mary Parish 1837 - 1987

THE DENIS HAYES FAMILY

Denis Hayes was a merchant. In the 1880's Denis owned N½ Lots 24 & 25 Con. 1. He first ran a general store in Marysville, and then, about 1891, purchased the James McCullough general store and house in Lonsdale. This store burned down and Denis relocated his business across Rock Street in the stone building which is still standing on top of the hill. His family lived in the frame house next to the store. Denis ran the store until his death in 1916 and then his eldest son Jack Hayes ran it until the 1930's. Denis had a large trade. Jack went out into the northern part of the township in a one horse wagon to buy butter and eggs and to bring store goods to the people. Many people paid in wood.

Denis and his wife, Kate Murphy, had eight children. They lived directly north of Marysville Church in the house which once belonged to Squire Michael Nealon.

1. Catherine Hayes (1874-1918) never married. Kate nursed her mother throughout a fatal diphtheria attack, contracted it herself, and followed her mother to the grave in ten days time. They died in Lonsdale and were buried at Marysville.
2. Mary Hayes (1875)—died in infancy
3. John Hayes (1877-1936) married Margaret Doyle (1880-1950) daughter of William Doyle and Ann McVicker of Marysville. John operated the general store in Lonsdale. They had nine children.
 1. Clarence Francis Hayes (1904-1949). Married Aileene Hunt (1905-1981) daughter of John Hunt and Roseann Hart of Read. They married in 1929 in Rochester, New York. Clarence owned a wholesale restaurant equipment business in Rochester, the C.F. Hayes, Company.
 1. Elizabeth Ann Hayes (1931-1981) Married 1953 to Bernard J. Galvin, son of James Galvin and Leona Garley of Rochester. Bernard was a pilot in the U.S. Navy.
 2. Joan Margaret Hayes b. 1938 in Rochester, N.Y. Married 1973 George L. Edenharder, son of Joseph Edenharder and Helene Mundschau of Jefferson, Wi. George is a Professor of Mathematics.\$
 2. Aletha Hayes (1906-1907) Lonsdale, Ontario
 3. Rita Hayes b. 1910. Married 1948 to Douglas Embury b. 1910, son of Edward Henry Embury and Ellie Marsh. Live in Windsor, Ontario.
 1. Janice Embury b. 1949, Belleville, Ont. Married 1974.
 2. John Embury b. 1949 (twin). Married 1975 Kathleen Nantais Duchene, daughter of Leslie Nantais. Live in Mississauga, Ontario.
 3. Donna Embury b. 1951 Belleville, Ont. Married 1971

- Joseph Sequin. Live in Windsor, Ontario.
4. Raymond Hayes b. 1912 Lonsdale, Ont. Never married. Lived in Rochester, N.Y.
 5. Angela Hayes b. 1914 Lonsdale, Ont. Married 1953 to Donald LeVere, son of Willis LeVere and Cecilia Hassett. Live in Rochester, N.Y.
 6. Dennis Joseph Hayes b. 1916 Lonsdale, Ontario. Married in Rochester, N.Y. to Rhea Langevin. They live in Reno, Nevada.
 7. Francis Hayes (1917-1965) buried Marysville. Married Ann Hudson of Boulter Ontario
 8. Wilfred Hayes b. 1919 Lonsdale, Ontario. Married 1952 to Betty Asseltine, daughter of Albert Asseltine and Mary Frances Doyle. They live in Corbyville, Ont.
 1. Michael Hayes b. 1954. Married Lynda Brown, daughter of Garnet Keith Brown and Mary Monica LaFord. Live in Burk's Falls, Ontario.
 9. Stewart Hayes b. 1922 Lonsdale, Ontario. Married 1954 Rochester N.Y. to Jeanne Devaney, daughter of Michael Devaney and Estella Lambrix. Live in Rochester, n.y.
 4. Rose Arabella Hayes (1878-1958) buried at Read, Ontario. Married 1904 to Dennis James Callaghan (1872-1965) son of Daniel Callaghan and Bridget Ward, grandson of Daniel C. Callaghan of County Cork and Johanna Desmond. They lived on the 5th concession. They had nine children:

 6. Franklin Callaghan b. 1914 Read. Married 1948 to Cecilia Jane Warner in Smiths Falls, Ont. Live in Killaloe, Ont.
 7. Adrian Ward Callaghan b. 1916 Read. Married 1944 in

Read to Helen Shannon, daughter of Edward Shannon and Agnes Power of Read, Ont. Live on 5th con. Tyendinaga.

1. Paul Callaghan b. 1945. Married 1970 to Marilyn Hurst, Belleville. Live in Belleville.
2. Ronald Callaghan b. 1948. Married Ann Meraw. They were married in Tweed in 1971. Live in St. Catherine's.
3. Jane Callaghan b. 1952. Married 1974 Read to Larry Pascoe. Live in Read.
4. Robert Callaghan b. 1951. Lives in Read.
5. Mary Anges Callaghan b. 1955. Lives in Read.
6. Terrence Callaghan b. 1957 m. Heather Coburn. Lives in Calgary.
7. Daniel Callaghan b. 1958 m. Mary Jane Koekman. Lives in Read.
8. Gerard Callaghan (1962-1966)
9. Helen Callaghan b. 1922, Read. Married 1945 to Edgar Allan (Ted) Jones of Asbury Park, N.J. They live in Santa Monica, Calif.
5. Agnes Hayes (1880-19) b. Marysville, Ont. d. Rochester, N.Y. Married 1913 to Michael Edward Doyle (1885-196), son of William Doyle and Ann McVicker of Marysville. Live in Rochester, N.Y.
6. Florence Hayes (1882-1966) b. Marysville, Ont. d. Detroit, Mi. buried Marysville. Married 1914 Marysville to Michael James Doyle (1882-1960), son of John Doyle and Ellen Hunt of Marysville, grandson of Michael Doyle and Catherine Hanlon of Marysville and Timothy Hunt and Mary Culhane of Erinsville, Ont. Originally of Glin, Co. Limerick, Ireland. Lived in Detroit, Michigan.
7. Frances Hayes (1885-1968) b. Marysville. D. Florida, buried Rochester, N.Y. Married 1921 in Read to Thomas Carly Jordan, son of John P. Jordan and Hannah Harcourt. D. 1967. Lived in Rochester N.Y.
8. Archibald Dennis Hayes (1888-1969) b. Marysville. D. Rochester, N.Y. Married 1920 in Marysville to Olivia Sherlock (1897-1985). Lived in Rochester, N.Y.

Bridget Ellen Hayes was born about 1847 in Ireland. She was confirmed in 1856 in Marysville. She married on February 17, 1881 in Marysville to Michael Lally. The family lived in Read, Ont. and later moved to Belleville. They had Five Children:

1. John Edward Lally (1882-1963). Married Joanna (Kennedy or Kelly)

2. Joseph Lally married and lived in St. Louis, Missouri.
3. Thomas J. Lally (1889-1953) Tom Lally was born in Belleville. He entered the Jesuits in 1908 and was ordained in 1923. He used to say Mass at Christmas time in Marysville. In 1928 he was made Director of the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs in Midland, Ont. The Martyrs were beatified in 1925 and canonized in 1930. At the shrine are the reconstructed ruins of Fort Ste. Marie which was the home of the martyrs for ten years from 1639-1649. In 1953 Father Thomas Lally was appointed a member of the Historic Sited Commission by the Ontario Government. In Oct. of 1953, after 25 years as the Director of the Shrine, Father Lally died at Midland, Ontario.
4. Mary Catherine (Kate) Lally n.m. d. 1916.
5. Francis (Frank) Lally. Lived in Arizona.

THE JOHN HAYES FAMILY

John Hayes was born about 1812 in County Limerick, Ireland. He emigrated to Marysville about 1848 at the height of the potato famine. With him were his wife Catherine Nealon and two children, Denis and Bridget. In the next two years, two more children were born, John in 1849 and Mary in 1850. I believe that his wife Catherine was related to Squire Michael Nealon of Marysville.

In November of 1850, just two years after immigrating, John Hayes was accidentally killed at age 38 when he was thrown from a wagon on his way home to Tyendinaga Township from Belleville. John was buried at Marysville Catholic church. The following summer his youngest daughter Mary died at age 1 year, 5 months, and 2 days. Mary was buried next to her father. Now his wife Catherine Nealon Hayes, at about 34 years of age, was left to raise the three remaining children: Denis, Bridget, and John Hayes. Catherine lived on Lot 25, Con. 2, South Range of Tyendinaga Township.

1. Denis Hayes b. c1844 Ireland; d. 1916 Marysville, Ont.; m. 1873 Catherine Murphy (c1845-1918), daughter of John Murphy and Rose Bulger of Marysville.
2. Bridget Hayes b. 1847 Ireland; d. c.1889; m. 1881 Marysville to Michael Lally (b. 1838 bap. St. Michael's, Belleville), son of Lawrence and Catherine Madden.
3. John Hayes b. 1849 Ontario; never married; d. 1924 Reno, Nevada; buried Marysville, Ont. When John was in his early 20's, he went west to Nevada. In 1903, the years in which Reno, Nevada was incorporated as a city, John Hayes was the Sheriff of Washoe County, of which Reno is the County Seat. Later John Hayes was the County Assessor for Washoe County from 1910-1923.
4. Mary Hayes b. 1850 Ontario; d. 1851 Marysville, Ont.
